
Standard Platform for Healthcare Buildings

In support of NHS England and NHS Improvement direction of travel on standardisation, Modern Methods of Construction (MMC), Off-Site Manufacture (OSM) and interest from our Clients, we have developed a proposal for a Standard Platform for use in the hospital built environment

Our Standard Platform uses the P22 evidenced-based Repeatable Rooms (RR) supported by Royal Colleges and NHSE/I.


We have "standardised" these rooms dimensionally to fit within a standard structural grid retaining clinical compliance and providing for structural efficiencies and MMC modular techniques.



We have tested the flexibility, resource content and cost of our platform with a 3-storey block accommodating Inpatient and Outpatient facilities.

Evidence shows that the platform is suitable for diagnostic and treatment areas.

The platform is scalable, and it is envisaged that the block can be stand-alone, linked to an existing facility or constructed as a complex of repeat blocks.




Our Standard Platform provides:
